**Subject:- Issuance of Driving Licenses to Persons with 100% Hearing Impairment - compliance of directions in CCPD Case No.14029/1141/2023 reg.**

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to the proceedings held on 04.08.2025 (copy enclosed) in CCPD Case No.14029/1141/2023 vide which the Hon'ble Court of Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities has directed the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways for dissemination of updated guidelines and technical changes to all the State governments to avoid hardships in the issuance of Driving Licenses to persons with 100% hearing impairment. The relevant extract of the order is reproduced as follows :-

*"The Ministry to reiterate OM No. RT-11021/40/2014-MVL dated 28.10.2016 to all State Governments/Union Territories and to coordinate with State agencies to clear all pending applications for driver's licenses of persons with hearing impairment without further delay."*


2. In this regard, it is pertinent to state that this Ministry vide letter No. RT-11021/40/2014-MVL dated 28.10.2016 (copy enclosed) has requested States/UTs to consider applications for driving licenses to hearing impaired applicants under Section 8(4) of the Motor Vehicles Act1988.

2.1 Further, an advisory has been issued by this Ministry vide letter No. RT-11021/40/2014-MVL dated 06.11.2023 regarding strict adherence to the extended guidelines of this Ministry while considering the applications for driving licenses to hearing impaired applicants.

3. In view of above, all States/UTs are requested to ensure compliance of aforementioned advisories in letter and spirit at their level as well as at the level of the ground-level executors in terms of said order in **CCPD Case No.14029/1141/2023**.
